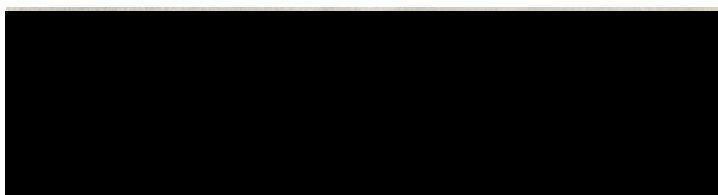

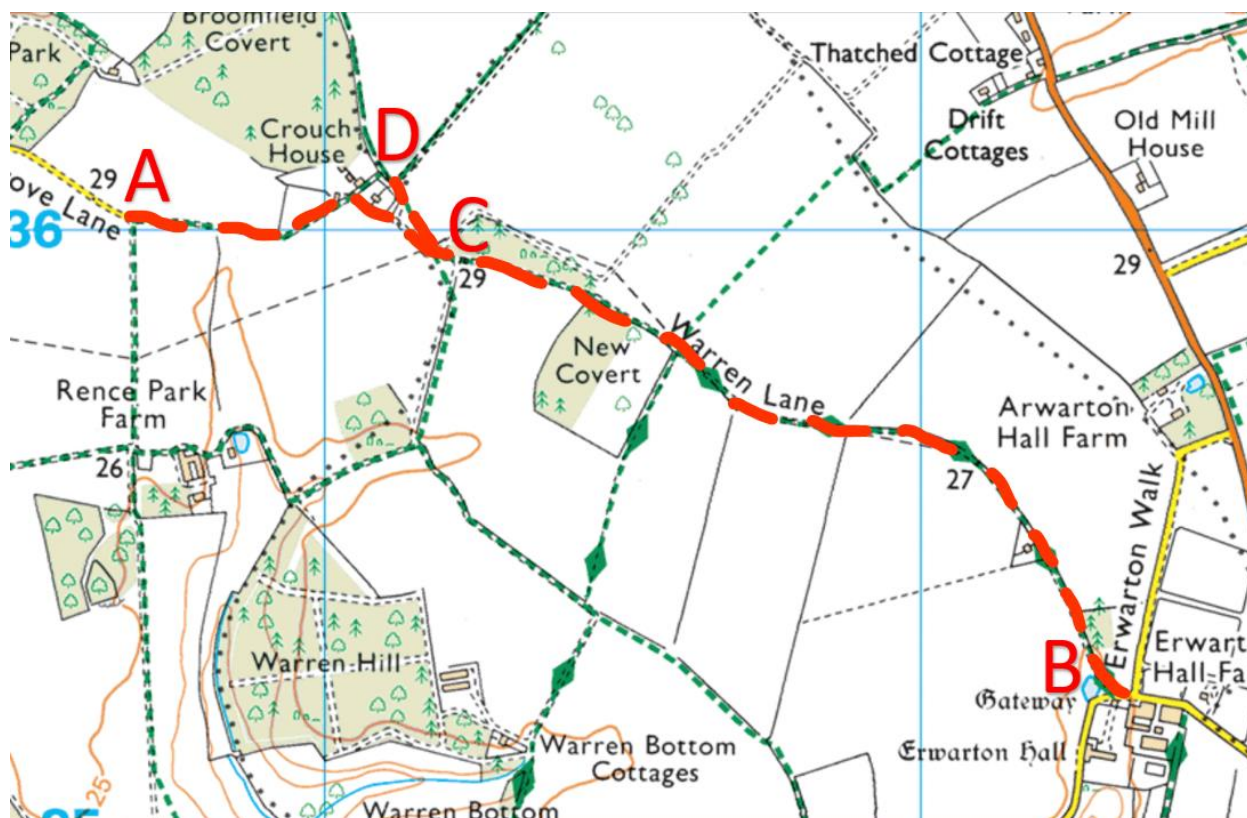
### Summary of Evidence
