hereby apply for an order under Section 53(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 modifying the Definitive Map and Statement for the area by:-

- a) Adding the Byway Open to All Traffic which runs from Point A (OSGR TL 93575 52947) the junction of the application route and Blacksmith Lane to Point B (OSGR TL 93430 53098) the junction of the application route and Thorpe Morieux Footpath 3.
- b) Upgrading of Thorpe Morieux Footpath 3 to Byway Open to All traffic which runs from Point B (OSGR TL 93430 53098) the junction of the application route and Thorpe Morieux Footpath 3 to Point C (OSGR TL 93829 53327) the junction of Thorpe Morieux Footpath 3 and Thorpe Morieux Footpath 4.
- c) Adding the Byway Open to All Traffic which runs from Point C (OSGR TL 93829 53327) the junction of Thorpe Morieux Footpath 3 and Thorpe Morieux Footpath 4 to Point D (OSGR TL 93799 53550) the junction of the application route and Green Road.
- d) Adding the Byway Open to All Traffic which runs from Point B (OSGR TL 93430 53098) the junction of Thorpe Morieux Footpath 3 and the application route to Point E (OSGR TL 92296 54104) the junction of the application route and Cockfield Footpath 18.
- e) Upgrading of Cockfield Footpath 18 to Byway Open to All traffic which runs from Point E (OSGR TL 92296 54104) the junction of the application route and Cockfield Footpath 18 to Point F (OSGR TL 92462 54344) the junction of Cockfield Footpath 18 and Cockfield Footpath 16.
- f) Upgrading of part of Cockfield Footpath 16 to Byway Open to All traffic which runs from Point F (OSGR TL 92462 54344) the junction of Cockfield Footpath 18 and Cockfield Footpath 16 to Point G (OSGR TL 92576 54424) the northern termination of the application route on Cockfield Footpath 16.

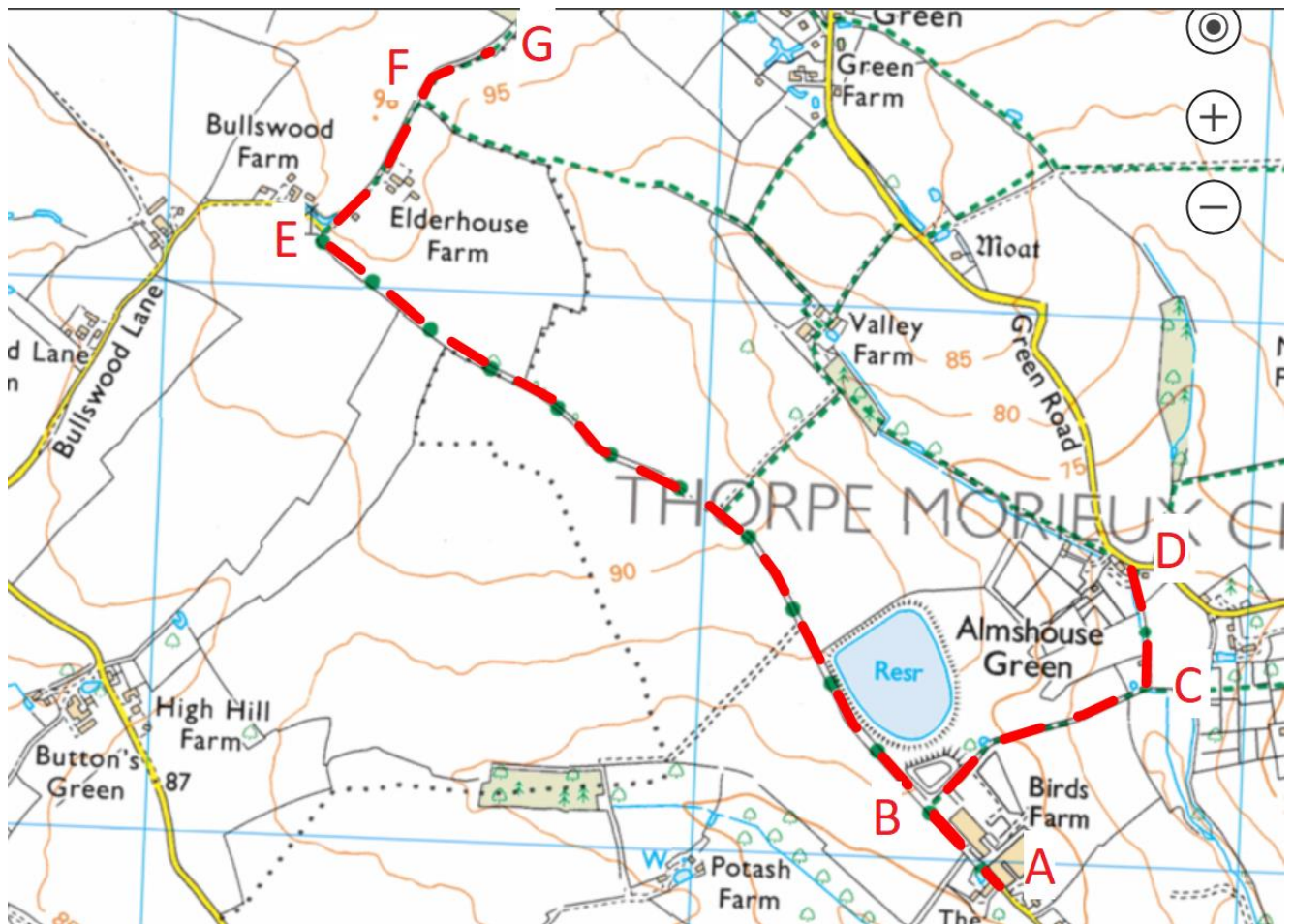
