hereby apply for an order under Section 53(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 modifying the Definitive Map and Statement for the area by:-

- a) Upgrading Metfield Footpath 4 to Public Bridleway from Point A on the application map (OSGR TM 29461 80524) the junction of Metfield Footpath 4, Low Road, The Street, St James Road and Mill Lane, to Point B (OSGR TM 29467 80958) the junction of Metfield Footpath 4, Metfield Footpath 5, Metfield Footpath 6 and Mill Lane.
- b) Upgrading part of Metfield Footpath 5 to Public Bridleway from Point B on the application map (OSGR TM 29467 80958) the junction of Metfield Footpath 4, Metfield Footpath 5, Metfield Footpath 6 and Mill Lane, to Point C (OSGR TM 29467 80975) the junction of Metfield Footpath 6 and Metfield Footpath 48.
- c) Upgrading part of Metfield Footpath 48 to Public Bridleway from Point C on the application map (OSGR TM 29467 80975) the junction of Metfield Footpath 6 and Metfield Footpath 48, to Point D (OSGR TM 29462 81045) the junction of Metfield Footpath 5 and Metfield Footpath 48.
- d) Upgrading part of Metfield Footpath 5 to Public Bridleway from Point C on the application map (OSGR TM 29462 81045) the junction of Metfield Footpath 5 and Metfield Footpath 48, to Point E (OSGR TM 29461 81076) the junction of Metfield Footpath 5 and the application route.
- e) Adding the Public Bridleway which runs from Point E on the application map (OSGR TM 29461 81076) the junction of Metfield Footpath 5 and the application route, to Point F (OSGR TM 29454 81175) the junction of the application route and Honeypot Lane.
- f) Adding the Public Bridleway which runs from Point F on the application map (OSGR TM 29454 81175) the junction of the application route and Honeypot Lane, to Point G (OSGR TM 29144 81595) the junction of Honeypot Lane, South Elmham Road and Mendham Footpath 20.

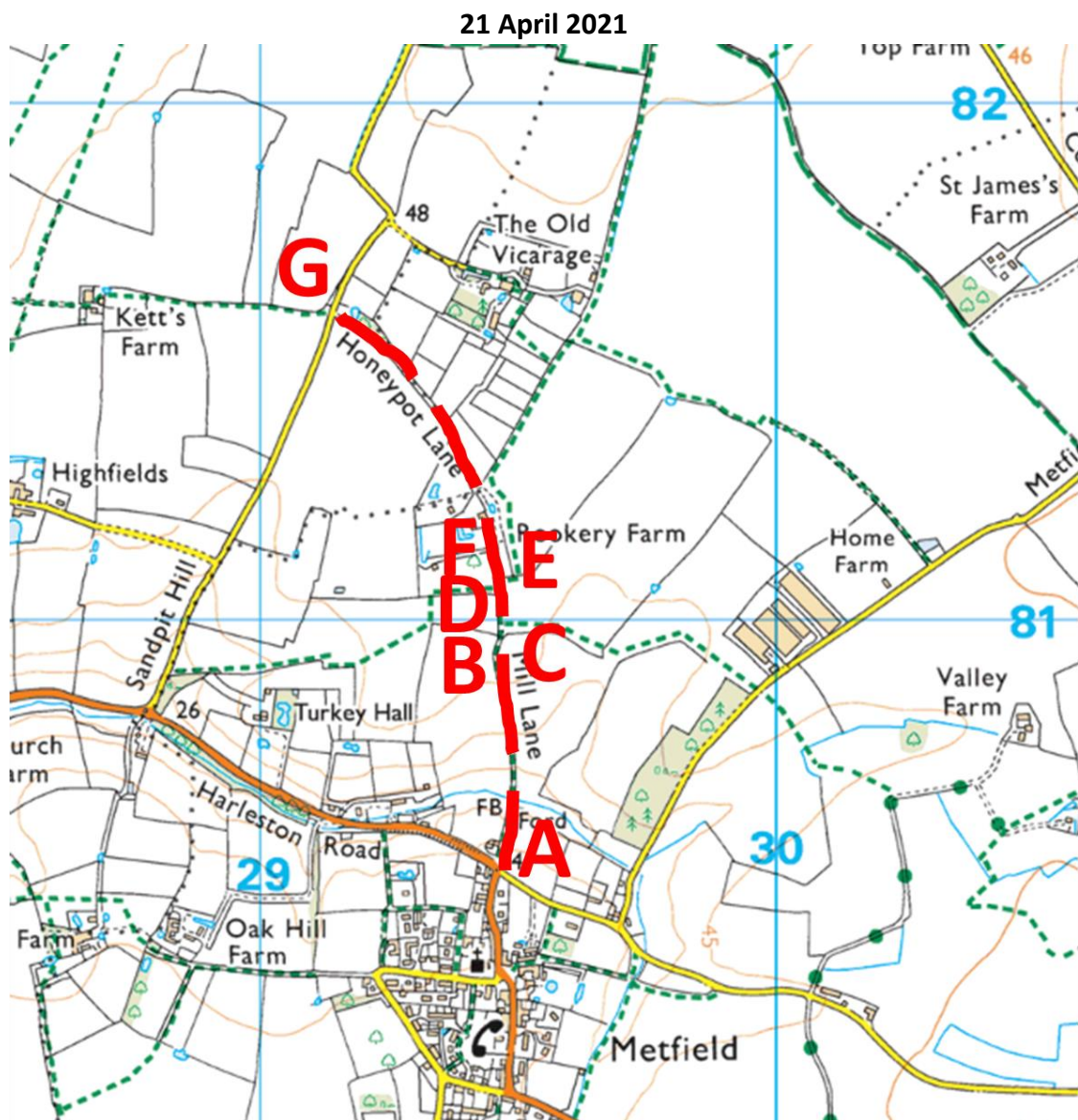
