- a) Upgrading Walsham Le Willows Footpath 21 to Public Bridleway from Point A on the application map (OSGR TM 01929 70607) the junction of Walsham Le Willows Footpath 21 and 5928 from C555 to 5929/5101, to Point B (OSGR TM 02127 70556) the junction of Walsham Lew Willows Footpath 21 and Walsham Le Willows Footpath 1.
- b) Upgrading part of Walsham Le Willows Footpath 1 to Public Bridleway from Point B on the application map (OSGR TM 02127 70556) the junction Walsham Le Willows Footpath 21 and Walsham Le Willows Footpath 1, to Point C (OSGR TM 03128 70302) the junction of Walsham Le Willows Footpath 1 and Walsham Road.

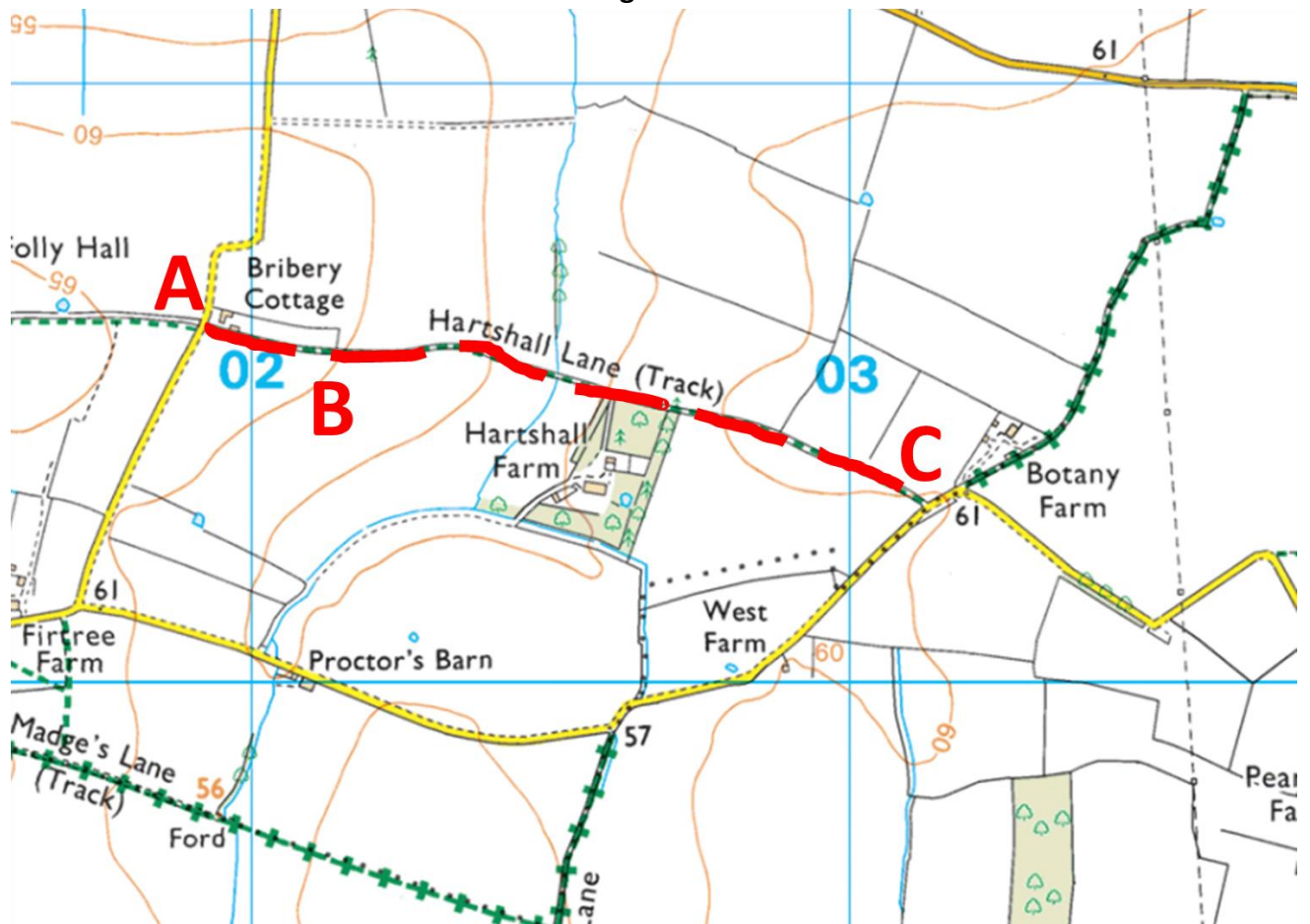
