Explanatory Note

My application is based on the fact that this path forms part of a route which is partially recorded as Great Barton Footpath No. 21. The latter section is a proven public footpath, having had that status since at least as long ago as early in the 19th century.

It is shown on a succession of Ordnance Survey one-inch maps covering a period from 1907 to 1954 as part of a continuous footpath with no other routes branching out of it which might have alternatively have been the continuation of the right of way beyond the south-eastern end of Footpath 21. It must, therefore, be indisputable that the section of the footpath which is the subject of this application carries the same public right of way on foot as Footpath No. 21.
